Sub: Application for letter of permission for functioning of Shri Jagadguru Panchacharya Education Society's Homoeopathic Medical College, 200 E, Tararani Chowk, Kolhapur-416003, Maharashtra for continuing BHMS course with intake capacity of 75 seats and 06 seats for M.D (Hom) in 02 subjects in Practice of Medicine and Pediatrics with 3 seats each for the academic year 2025-26- regd.

Sir,

Shri Jagadguru Panchacharya Education Society's Homoeopathic Medical College has applied for permission for sanction of BHMS course with 75 seats and 06 seats for M.D (Hom) in 02 subjects in Practice of Medicine and Pediatrics with 3 seats each for the academic year 2025-26. The College has submitted the Part I information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. MARBH conducted Inspection on 27.02.2025 & 28.02.2025, followed by hearing on 07.05.2025. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards to be fulfilled as per the prevailing regulations under clauses 26 and 28 of the NCH Act 2020. On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board observed the following shortfalls: -

1. Teaching faculty.

- The principal is holding the post of professor in department of Materia medica. As per MES 2024 Principal should be a separate post.
- Professor in the department of Materia medica.
- 01 assistant professor deficient in department of Organon.
- Professor of Research methodology and biostatistics.

As evident from the above statement, a total number of three teachers are deficient against the requirement of 40+1 for 100 seats UG college (As specified in MES,2024). Pursuant to **F.No.:3-2/MARBH/NCH/2025-26/162-169 dated 16/04/2025** issued by MARBH, a college can avail 10% relaxation against the required number of teachers for Academic Year 2025-26 only. After allowing relaxation of 10%, college has no deficiency in teaching staff. However, such relax number of teachers may be appointed at the earliest for smooth conduct of course.

2. Hospital functioning


- Patient details are not properly recorded.
- Labour room is available with necessary equipment's, but no delivery is conducted so far.

3. Miscellaneous

- NABL accreditation for clinical laboratory not done.
- Diet is not provided to IPD patients.

- c) The salary of teaching staff and non-teaching staff is not as per MES 2024.
4. Considering the above observations during inspection and hearing, MARBH has decided to issue **Conditional Permission to Shri Jagadguru Panchacharya Education Society's Homoeopathic Medical College, 200 E, Tararani Chowk, Kolhapur-416003, Maharashtra for continuing BHMS course with intake capacity of 75 seats and 06 seats for M.D (Hom) in 02 subjects in Practice of Medicine and Pediatrics with 3 seats each for the academic year 2025-2026 on the basis of following condition:-**
- a) The salary of the staff should be as per the criteria mentioned in MES 2024.
- b) Proper diet should be provided to IPD patients.
5. All admissions shall be made from NEET/AIAPGET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats and 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 75 UG seats and 06 PG seats shall be treated as All India Quota. Counseling for seats under all India quotas shall be conducted by respective Counseling Authority of State/UT govt as designated by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT.
6. The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET/AIAPGET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.
7. Conditions under point 3 should be fulfilled within a period of one month and the compliance report shall be submitted for verification to the office, failing which permission for the academic year 2025-26 may be withdrawn.
