Sub:- Admissions during the year 2017-18 in respect of SJPES's Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Kolhapur (Maharashtra)—regd.

Sir.

I am directed to refer the provisions prescribed under sub regulation 3(4) of HCC(MSR), 2013, wherein, the existing college has to fulfill the minimum standard requirement of infrastructure, teaching & training facilities for consideration of grant of permission for undertaking admission in the coming academic year. Further, as per the provision of sub regulation 3(9) of HCC(MSR), 2013, if the existing colleges fails to achieve full compliance of the requirements as specified in the regulation by 31.12.2014 the college may be stopped for taking admission in BHMS Course.

- 2. In order to verify the compliance of the College, CCH has conducted the inspection of SJPES's Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Kolhapur (Maharashtra) on 16.07.2017 and furnished the inspection report for granting permission to take admissions during A.Y. 2017-18.
- 3. After considering the provisions of HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, inspection report of CCH and policy of the Central Government for granting conditional permission during the session 2017-18, permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to SJPES's Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Kolhapur (Maharashtra) for continuing admissions in BHMS course with Seventy Five (75) seats and PG course in Practice of Medicine and Pediatrics with 3 seats each for the academic session 2017-18 subject to condition that the college shall fulfill the following requirements by 31st December, 2017 which will be verified for granting permission from the academic session 2018-19: -

- (i) all the Minimum Standard Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards Requirement of Homoeopathic Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations 2013" by 31st December 2017 to get permission for a period not exceeding five years. Failing which, all the existing colleges, which are not able to achieve full compliance of the requirement as specified in these regulations by the 31st December, 2017, shall be denied permission from academic year 2018-19 onwards and action as envisaged under section 19 of the Act shall be initiated against all such colleges apart from rejection of their applications under sections 12A, which have been under consideration by way of conditional permissions or denials"; and
- (ii) all the requirements under the provisions of the HCC Act, 1973 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.
- 4. The fulfillment of the conditions attached to the permission given above may be made within the specified time period and compliance report should be submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCH also. The CCH will verify by means of an inspection that the conditions have been fulfilled and submit a report in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the session 2018-19.
- 5. The College has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 by December, 2017 for continuing admissions during the subsequent years. CCH shall verify the compliance well in time for considering the admissions during the Academic Year 2018-19 and furnish the recommendations to the Central Government.
