Sub:- Admissions for the academic year 2019-20 in existing BHMS Course with intake capacity of 75 seats and PG Course in 2 subjects namely Practice of Medicine and Paediatrics with 03 seats each at SJPE'S (Shri Jagat Guru Panchacharya Edu. Society) Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Kolhapur - regd.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the provisions prescribed under Section 12C of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and regulations made thereunder. In order to verify the compliance of availability of standards by the College, the Board of Governors to CCH has conducted inspection of SJPE'S (Shri Jagat Guru Panchacharya Edu. Society) Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Kolhapur on 25.03.2019 and furnished recommendation for allowing admission in I-BHMS Course and MD (Hom.) course for the session 2019-20.

2. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, recommendations of the Board of Governors to CCH, permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to SJPE'S (Shri Jagat Guru Panchacharya Edu. Society) Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Kolhapur for continuing admissions in I- BHMS course during the academic year 2019-20 with intake capacity of 75 seats and MD(Hom) Course in two subjects namely Practice of Medicine and Paediatrics with three seats (03) in each subjects.

3. It is further informed that 15% of undergraduate and 15% of post graduate seats of the permitted intake capacity shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats shall be conducted by the concerned State Government. If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the concerned State Government to admit students as per their rules/ reservation policies/norms. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to co-operate with the Central counseling for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**

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4. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as irregular and action will be initiated under HCC Act & Regulations made thereunder.
5. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCH and the Central Government.
6. The College has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 by 31st December, 2019 for continuing admissions during the subsequent year. A copy of the compliance report shall be submitted by the college to CCH under intimation to this Ministry. Subsequently, CCH shall verify the compliance well in time for considering the admissions during the Academic Year 2020-21 and furnish the recommendation to the Central Government.
