Sub:- Admissions for the academic year 2018-19 in existing BHMS course with intake capacity of 75 seats and PG Course in 2 subjects namely Practice of Medicine and Pediatrics with 03 seats each at SJPES's (Shri Jagat Guru Panchacharya Edu. Society) Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, 200, E, Tararani Chowk, Kolhapur - 416003.

Sir,

I am directed to refer the provisions prescribed under sub regulation 3(4) of HCC (MSR), 2013, wherein, the existing college has to fulfill the minimum standard requirement of infrastructure, teaching & training facilities by 31.12.2014 for consideration of grant of permission for undertaking admission in the coming academic year. Further, as per the provision of sub regulation 3(9) of HCC (MSR), 2013, if the existing colleges fail to achieve full compliance of the requirements as specified in the regulation by 31.12.2014 the college may be stopped for taking admission in existing Courses.

2. In order to verify the compliance of the College, CCH has conducted the inspection of SJPES's (Shri Jagat Guru Panchacharya Edu. Society) Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, 200, E, Tararani Chowk, Kolhapur on 26.06.2018 and furnished the report of inspection of CCH to the Ministry for further consideration in the matter of granting permission for the A.Y. 2018-19 and recommended as follows:-

“Recommended for allowing admission in 1st BHMS course for the session 2018-19 with the intake capacity allowed earlier subject to the removal of deficiencies reflected in the report of inspection before 31.12.2018.”

3. After considering the provisions of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013, inspection report of CCH and policy of the Central Government for granting conditional permission during the session 2018-19, permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to SJPES's (Shri Jagat Guru Panchacharya Edu. Society) Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, 200, E, Tararani Chowk, Kolhapur for continuing admissions in BHMS course with Seventy Five (75) seats and for MD (Hom) in Practice of Medicine and Pediatrics with 03 seats each for the academic session 2018-19 subject to condition that the college shall fulfill the following requirements by 31st

December, 2018 which will be verified for granting permission from the academic session 2019-2020: -

- i. All the Minimum Standard Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards Requirement of Homoeopathic Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations 2013" by 31st December 2018 to get permission for a period not exceeding five years. Failing which, all the existing colleges, which are not able to achieve full compliance of the requirement as specified in these regulations by the 31st December, 2018, shall be denied permission from academic year 2019-20 onwards and action as envisaged under section 19 of the Act shall be initiated against all such colleges apart from rejection of their applications under sections 12A, which have been under consideration by way of conditional permissions or denials"; and
 - ii. All the requirements under the provisions of the HCC Act, 1973 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.
 4. The College has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 by December, 2018 and submit a compliance report to CCH under intimation to this Ministry for continuing admissions during the subsequent academic year. Subsequently, CCH shall verify the compliance well in time for considering the admissions during the Academic Year 2019-20 and furnish the recommendations to the Central Government.
 5. Please acknowledge the receipt of this letter.
